What is MOVE?

CIY (Christ in Youth) provides different conferences for different age groups across the nation. MOVE is the CIY conference specifically for high school students; it is a weeklong, high-energy, community driven high school conference.

Who can go to MOVE?

MOVE is open to all high school students. This includes incoming freshman and graduating seniors. So, if you are currently in 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade you can go!

When is MOVE?

We will meet at ACC Sunday, July 18th and return to ACC Saturday, July 24th

Where is MOVE?

MOVE is held on the campus of Biola University in La Mirada, California.

Where else are we going on this trip?

On Thursday, July 22, we will be going to Huntington Beach for a few hours. Other than that we will be on Biola's campus the entire time for the MOVE conference.

How are we getting to MOVE and Huntington Beach?

We will be using charter buses

How much does MOVE cost this year?

\$475 per student. This covers charter buses for transportation, lodging, all food while at MOVE and of course the conference registration fee.

How much extra money do I need to bring?

Around \$50...you will need to buy your own lunch while at Huntington Beach plus any extra money for snacks and merch while at MOVE. We will also stop a few times when driving to and from Biola University so bring money for a couple fast food meals and snacks .

When do I have to turn my money and forms in?

In order to reserve your spot you must turn in a \$75 non-refundable deposit and your 2 forms by May 26th! If you turn in your deposit and forms late, the cost for you will go up \$50 because of the late registration fee. Remember, this is first come first serve! Spots are limited so get your deposit and forms in asap! The final balance is due June 14th.

What forms do I need?

There are 2 forms you need to fill out and turn in. One is the CIY Medical Release Form and the second is the Adventure Christian Church Parental Consent Form. Forms are available at the church and on the Resonate|High website.

How do I pay for MOVE?

All student payments and registrations are done online. You can pay with credit card or e-check. More details and info can be found on the Resonate|High website.

Why should I go?

Because this is going to be the absolute best trip we go on all year! You don't want to miss MOVE 2010! This will be a week of making new friends, growing closer with your close friends, and experiencing God in a whole new way!

- Extra money for travel, merch, offering, beach trip, etc...






What NOT to bring

July 18th

11:00pm - Meet at ACC and get checked in

July 19th

3:00am - Buses arrive at ACC

3:30am - Buses leave for Biola University

12:00pm – Arrive at Biola University

July 22nd

11:30am – Leave for Huntington Beach 4:30pm – Arrive back at Biola University in time for dinner

July 23rd

11:30pm – Leave for ACC 8:00am – Arrive at ACC

What if...

A parent/guardian needs to get a hold of their child?

You will have my personal cell number which I will have with me at all times. You will also have contact info for the MOVE staff at Biola University. All the adult leaders will also have their cell phones so that Brian Haas (High School Pastor) can reach them at all times for any reason.

A student needs to get a hold of their parent/guardian?

The student will go to an adult leader and explain the situation. That leader will bring the student to Brian Haas (High School Pastor) and will be allowed to use his phone to call home.

A student gets hurt while on the trip?

Regardless of the severity of the injury, the person(s) on the student's Parental Consent Form will be contacted and notified of the incident. If the student requires medical attention they can be taken to the local emergency room.

NOTE: it is the responsibility of the student to tell an adult leader if they are sick, injured, etc...

A student is found using a cell phone or ipod while at MOVE?

The adult leader will confiscate the cell phone or ipod and give it to Brian Haas (High School Pastor) who will have all items safely locked. The item will be returned upon arriving at Adventure Christian Church

A student is found with alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc...?

The parent/guardian will be notified and will have to make arrangements to pick up their student within 24 hours.

A student is found in the dorm of the opposite gender?

The parent/guardian will be notified and will have to make arrangements to pick up their student within 24 hours.
