What is Beach Trip?

Beach Trip is a great trip for all High School students! Who can go to Beach Trip?

Beach Trip is open to all high school students. This includes incoming freshman and graduating seniors. So, if you are currently in 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade you can go!

When is Beach Trip?

We will meet at Adventure on Monday, June 17 at 6:15am and return to Adventure on Friday, June 21 around 5pm.

Where is Beach Trip?

Beach Trip is held at SeaCrest Hotel and Conference Center in Pismo Beach, California.

How much does Beach Trip cost this year?

\$395

Includes transportation, lodging, all food except 2 travel meals and one off-site lunch **How much extra money do I need to bring?**

Students don't need extra money except for 2 travel meals and 1 lunch. If you want to have money for snacks, etc... \$30-\$50.

When do I have to turn my money and forms in?

May 26: \$100 deposit deadline! (\$50 late fee if paid after)

June 2: Final Balance due

What forms do I need?

We need two completed forms: Medical Release & Registration Form

How do I pay for Beach Trip?

You can pay one of three ways: online, cash or check (made out to ACC)

What if...

A parent/guardian needs to get a hold of their child?

You will have my personal cell number which I will have with me at all times. All the adult leaders will also have their cell phones so that Brian Haas (High School Pastor) can reach them at all times for any reason.

A student needs to get a hold of their parent/guardian?

The student will go to an adult leader and explain the situation. That leader will bring the student to Brian Haas (High School Pastor) and will be allowed to use his phone to call.

A student gets hurt while on the trip?

Regardless of the severity of the injury, the person(s) on the student's Parental Consent Form will be contacted and notified of the incident. If the student requires medical attention they can be taken to the local emergency room. NOTE: it is the responsibility of the student to tell an adult leader if they are sick, injured, etc...

A student is found using a cell phone or ipod while at Beach Trip?

The adult leader will confiscate the cell phone or ipod and give it to Brian Haas (High School Pastor) who will have all items safely locked. The item will be returned upon arriving at Adventure Christian Church

A student is found with alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc...?

The parent/guardian will be notified and will have to make arrangements to pick up their student within 24 hours.

A student is found in the dorm of the opposite gender?

The parent/guardian will be notified and will have to make arrangements to pick up their student within 24 hours.

A student adds charges to the room?

Student and parent are responsible for any additional charges to the room (damages, extra cleaning, etc...)



What to bring

Things to bring (1 carry-on, 1 luggage, bedding)

- Pillow/ Bedding or sleeping bag (will be sleeping on beds. 4 people per room)
- Bible
- Pen
- Clothing for 5 days (warm/cold/beach)
- Swimsuit and beach towel
- Personal toiletry items
- Athletic equipment for free time/ beach time
- Games (cards, board games, etc...) for free time
- Camera
- Watch or alarm clock
- Extra money for travel, snacks, etc...

What NOT to bring

- Ipod Beach Trip 2013 is going "Unplugged" to ensure the best experience and opportunity to connect with God!
- CELL PHONE you have the option to leave your phone at home or check it in with the Resonate staff. This is to eliminate distractions and to guarantee the safety of students
- Alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc...
- Refrigerators or air-conditioners
- Skateboards (Conference Center rules)
